ADF Peace Operations Training Centre and Protection Workshop

In 2017, the ADF delivered a specialised forum for key education and training staff to examine the cross-cutting themes currently challenging UN missions and multi-dimensional aspects of current operations in areas of armed conflict, with WPS being a key focus. Participants were drawn from respective Peace Operations Training Centres and other relevant training organisations (military, government, non-government, civilian and overseas personnel), including representatives from the UN Department of Peacekeeping Operations, the United Nations Organisation Mission in Democratic Republic of the Congo and Indonesian Directing Staff.

The aim of the 2017 Gender and Protection Workshop was: to examine cross cutting themes; analyse current education and training practices across regional training centres; identify best practice; and determine areas for further development. Regional level outcomes entail incorporating a more robust education and training regime, including training centre support and cooperation through production of resources and collaborative training teams.
